- ▶ Have changed addresses or names, or
- ▶ Are a new citizen, or
- ▶ Have not voted in a while or have never voted in Missouri, or
- ▶ Finished probation or parole

Be Informed

Important dates regarding voting

- **August 28:** New voting law goes into effect, which requires voters to show a non-expired government-issued photo ID to vote
- **October 12:** Last day to register to vote in the November General Election
- **September 27:** Absentee voting for the general election begins
- **October 24/25 – November 7 (Two weeks before election):** No-excuse early voting period
- **November 8:** General Election Day

Registering voters, at its core, is political speech and therefore protected by the First Amendment. Rather than enacting legislation to encourage and increase participation in the democratic process, the politicians in Jefferson City pass laws that criminalize voter engagement and mobilization efforts.

As a volunteer, you can register people to vote

- ▶ You must register as a solicitor if you plan to register more than 10 people to vote in an election cycle
- ▶ You must be at least 18 years of age and a registered voter in Missouri.

ANY VOTER REGISTRATION SOLICITOR WHO KNOWINGLY FAILS TO REGISTER WITH THE SECRETARY OF STATE IS GUILTY OF A CLASS THREE ELECTION OFFENSE.

VOTER REGISTRATION SOLICITORS SHALL REGISTER FOR EVERY ELECTION CYCLE THAT BEGINS ON THE DAY AFTER THE GENERAL ELECTION AND ENDS ON THE DAY OF THE GENERAL ELECTION TWO YEARS LATER. A VOTER REGISTRATION SOLICITOR SHALL BE AT LEAST EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE AND SHALL BE A REGISTERED VOTER IN THE STATE OF MISSOURI. 113.205.1
